Most grades also incorporate a craft or other fun activity to tie into the book topic. It's a great chance for kids to connect, while learning new techniques on how to sight read, introduce new vocabulary and make grade level reading fun!

Brown Bag Book Club is an optional activity meaning that students do not have to participate every month. If the student plans to attend during a given month we hope that they will be familiar with the book either by reading the book themselves or having a parent read to them. We do call the BBBC 'Brown Bag' for a reason! Please make sure your child has a sack lunch from home the day of the club meeting, but if they need to get hot lunch that day, that's okay. Eating is important too.
